Order your drink without a straw to avoid contaminating and harming the local fauna



Get the styrofoam out of your life and choose containers that are friendly to the environment.



Bring your own cloth bag to avoid the contamination of our bay and lagoons.



Use a thermos or reusable glass wherever you go or choose drinks with recyclable containers (cans, glass bottles)



In your business, install and/or use containers to separate waste and promote recycling



If you have a business, avoid giving out plastic bags and containers, straws and styrofoam



Replace plastic with aluminium, brown paper, cloth napkins, when you need to wrap or cover food



If you see plastic waste, pick it up and take it to a container.

Don't be indifferent!



Burning plastic waste is prohibited in Chacahua; avoid being fined



Install and/or use water dispensers instead of plastic bottles

Did you know that plastic and styrofoam contain toxic substances that are released with heat, causing cancer and other health problems, in addition to polluting the environment?
